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Speech and Language Evaluations are designed to assess a child's expressive and receptive language skills and how a language disorder affects his learning. The evaluation may be either initiated by the parent or recommended by the school. The evaluations are conducted by LDA's professional staff of Speech and Language Pathologists who have many years of experience working with children.

The evaluation consists of:

- A parent intake session.
- One testing session (approximately 1-1/2 to 2 hours).
- A follow-up session in which parents receive a written report of testing results.
