College Advocacy(Survival) Training

This course is conducted in a one-to-one setting with a special educator and lasts for six or eight weeks depending upon the needs of the individual student.

Topics of Discussion include the following:

- *Discussion of the diagnostic report (if there is one) to determine what type of learner the student is and how that impacts learning in the classroom.

- *Differences between high school and college

- *Is the student prepared to leave for college and become an independent learner

- *Strategies for Advocacy with the Disability Coordinator as well as teachers

- *Reinforcement of organization and study skills and what is necessary to be successful at the college level
